Planning Coffee Service Before and/or After Worship Services

Most churches now use Air Pot or Shuttle brewing systems that are installed in a kitchen.

Coffee is brewed directly into a thermal server, (either Air Pot – about 10 cups of coffee; or higher capacity Shuttle - 25-50 cups of coffee) then transported on a cart to a welcoming or meal service area of the church.





>> A single **Air Pot system** brews about 10 cups of coffee every 10 minutes; **Shuttle brewing systems** brew either one or two 25 or 50 cup pots of coffee every 10 minutes.

Most churches have **one brewer, and several Air Pots or Shuttles.** The coffee service team will begin brewing coffee, on average, 30 minutes before members are expected to arrive for Worship.



The Bolder the Coffee











Pura Vida Coffee is proud to offer Choice Organic Teas for sale to our customers. They are a Seattle based manufacturer of *Fair Trade CertifiedTM* Organic tea. Listed below are the teas that we currently stock (all have 16 tea bags per box).

<u>Organic Green Teas-</u> These teas offer a range of flavor, the fresh character results from limited processing during production.

Dragon Well	Nutty aroma w/finish of lingering bittersweetness.
Peach Green	Green tea infused with ripe peaches.
Jasmine Green	Jasmine blossoms mixed w/green tea.
Mint Green	Green tea and spearmint from North Africa.

Organic Oolong Teas- These teas are partially oxidized, creating a flavor between green teas (not oxidized) and black teas (fully oxidized).

Oolong	Earthiness w/hints of smoke lingering finish & delightful aroma

Organic White Teas- These teas are the least processed of all, tender buds and leaves are hand plucked, gently withered and dried.

Organic Black Teas- These teas are fully oxidized to develop a stronger flavor.

Chai Spice	Rich Assam black teas of Brahmaputra Valley and cardamom.		
Earl Grey Lavender	Black tea from India and Ceylon with bergamot citrus and lavender blossoms.		
Decaf Earl Grey	Clean and bright with deep citrus notes.		
Mango Black	Black Ceylon flavored with mango and vanilla.		

Herbal Teas- These teas include any infusion made from flowers, bark, fruit, or leaves of any plant other than true tea. They contain no caffeine.

Ginger Blend	Ginger, aroma of lemon, fennel and sweet licorice root.		
Chamomile Mint	Chamomile and mint infused with bergamot.		
Licorice Mint	Licorice adds sweetness to the mint leaf.		
Blackberry Hibiscus	Herbs, leaves and berries infused with blackberry.		
Vanilla Rooibos	Rich in minerals and antioxidants. Leaves of South African bush with vanilla.		
Peppermint	Aromatic, slightly spicy flavor from volcanic hillsides in Pacific NW.		

Pura Vida Founder's Story

At Harvard Business School, John Sage and Chris Dearnley became close friends. After graduation with MBA's in 1989, however, their lives diverged. Six years out of school, Dearnley forsook his business career and, with his wife, started a Vineyard church in San Jose, Costa Rica. Sage, meanwhile, began his marketing work for Microsoft and later Starwave.

Sage and Dearnley credit a moment of inspiration for changing their lives. They developed an innovative business plan for a non-profit internet coffee company called Pura Vida. Money from the sale of Pura Vida's fair trade products, along

with customer donations and corporate grants, *helped pay for* ministries in San Jose, Costa Rica.

The Pura Vida Coffee legacy was passed onto present ownership in 2004. The foundation turned into Pura Vida Create Good and expanded into coffee growing regions in Africa and South America. Despite a new name, it still maintains its philanthropic roots through partnering with FundaVida, Chris Dearnley's non-profit, and expanding support to other non-profits geared towards helping at-risk children in coffee producing countries around the world.

The **peak time** for coffee service is usually before or after worship services – whether they occur on a Sunday or another day of the week.

Brewer Recommendation

Option 1: Air Pot Brewer



Brews an air pot every 10 minutes. Air pot contains 10-12 cups of coffee.

About 70 cups of coffee per hour.

Also brews half pots – about 5-6 cups of coffee.


Serving a great cup of coffee, to several hundred first time visitors and members, before and after multiple Worship services presents unique logistical challenges!

In addition, during the week, coffee is served in Church Offices and *other facilities on campus* such as a cafeteria, preschool or school.

We typically install an air pot brewing system (see page 10) in church office and/or school breakrooms.

Churches with large congregations often freshly grind whole bean coffee and then brew into 3 gallon (50 cup) thermal servers to meet demand before or after worship services.

Many churches now operate *Coffee or Espresso shops* as a component of community outreach, and in addition to great Fair Trade Organic coffees and teas, Pura Vida supplies syrups, branded cups, and other service items.

Air pot brewers are typically installed in office and/or school breakrooms as well.

Many churches host world markets or other events to raise money for church outreach projects. Donors purchasing one or more bags of Pura Vida coffee enjoy great coffee at home plus the church keeps the net proceeds from coffee sales.

In many cases, our *Create Good*Foundation will also issue a matching grant to encourage donors to participate.

Option #1: Traditional Bulk Fundraising

Our traditional bulk fundraising program allows you to purchase our 12 oz bags of coffee at a discounted price and then sell them at retail (for whatever price you choose), using the profit to support your church project or program.

You can either order in advance to have on-hand for your event or take pre-orders from individuals and distribute the coffee later. This is our most popular fundraising program!



Option #2: Online Fundraising

Register by emailing us at *info@puravidacoffee.com*. Once we receive the form we will create a fundraising code specific to your organization and a link for your website. The link is placed on your website which directs people to our web store. By using this link, we are able to track all sales related to your organization.

Spread the word to all your friends, family, and neighbors about your fundraiser. Anyone who uses the link from your website will generate funds for your organization. Receive your funds as a donation from us on a quarterly basis (calculated based on percentage of sales, net of shipping costs).


